Re: Lemoyne Road & Middleton Pike Waterline Update

Dear Residents:

Bids were received for the waterline project scheduled for Lemoyne, Pemberville, and Middleton Pike Roads. Subsequently, the Northwestern Water and Sewer District's Board of Trustees awarded the contract to Anderzack-Pitzen Construction "APC".

APC is scheduled to begin construction immediately after the Thanksgiving holiday on December 1st, with completion occurring at the end of March, early April time frame. Meantime, Construction staking will take place within the next week and a half.

The District has selected Howard Noel of Poggemeyer Design Group as its construction inspector for this project. Howard has over thirty years of inspection experience and is well versed in this type of construction. A mailing will be sent notifying those residents interested in tapping once construction is complete. In addition and upon request, the District will send information on the USDA's 504 program which provides financial assistance to qualifying residents who own and reside in their homes and are over 62 years of age.

We will do everything to minimize the inconveniences that you may experience and we will continue to keep you informed on the progress and schedule of this project.
