New Board of Trustee

Annual Customer Meeting Held on 3/9/2006

Approximately 55 users, employees and elected officials attended the District's annual customer meeting on Thursday, March 9, 2006. Presentations at the meeting included a ten-year District growth summary, a contingency plan overview, GIS and Pictometry capabilities and an update for new construction projects.

The District holds its customer information meeting annually on the second Thursday in March.

Village of Weston Joined the District

On February 1, 2006, the village of Weston transferred all water and sanitary sewer responsibilities to the District. This included all meter readings, billing, collecting, operations, taps, repairs, emergency needs, OUPS locating, etc.

Village of Bairdstown to Join the District

The village has taken preliminary steps to join the District. The village purchases water from the village of Bloomdale, yet Bloomdale operates the system. Bairdstown feels they can use additional help in the operations and planning of their system.

CCR Report

By the end of June, you will have received your Consumer Confidence Report ("CCR") report as mandated by the Federal EPA. The report explains your water quality level and testing results for the most recent year.

You now can pay your bill by credit card by completing the necessary information located on the back of your bill or by calling the customer service department with your credit card information. This is a one-time payment option and if you would like to pay monthly using your credit card, you must provide the necessary information on the back of your bill or call every month.
