Taylor Recognizes Northwestern Water and Sewer District for Excellent Financial Accountability

Wood County – Auditor of State Mary Taylor’s office presented Northwestern Water and Sewer District officials with the “Making Your Tax Dollars Count” award for their fiscal year 2009 audit. Fewer than five percent of all Ohio government agencies are eligible for this award.

“I commend the Northwestern Water and Sewer District for its commitment to fiscal accountability. Congratulations on your hard work and for being trustworthy stewards of taxpayer dollars,” Taylor said.

Certain criteria must be met to receive the “Making Your Tax Dollars Count” award. Among these requirements:

- The entity must complete and submit a Comprehensive Annual Financial Report (CAFR).
- There must be no findings or issues present in the audit report.
- There must be no other financial concerns involving the entity.
