Truman Road to SR 582 Along Lemoyne Road

Dear Resident:

The Northwestern Water & Sewer District ("District") is constructing a waterline to support Northeast Wood County. In addition, the waterline will support the future Job Ready Site (JRS) aka Dominion Energy property and future economic development in the area. The waterline will also provide fire protection (hydrants), as well as the opportunity for you to tap (consistent water quality).

The current plan is to connect to our existing line located north of Garling on Lemoyne Road and extend it south on Lemoyne Road to SR 582. From SR 582 the line will extend to the east to a water tower that is currently under construction and continue to Pemberville Road. At this time, the plan is to extend the waterline to the north and south on Pemberville road but the distance has not yet been determined.


We have been speaking to many folks along the proposed route regarding easements. As well, we will continue to keep all residents notified as to the final route and time frame for construction. We anticipate the plans will be finalized within the next two weeks.
