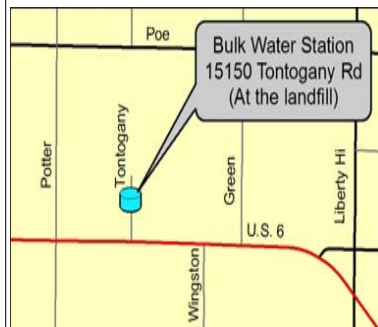

NOTICE TO WATER HAULERS

The Northwestern Water and Sewer District is a separate governmental entity who purchases water from the City of Bowling Green and resells it to others in the County.

You can purchase water at the bulk water stations using the District's plastic access card. It is simple and easy to use and is similar to using a bank's 24 hour automated teller machine with a card and PIN number for safe, secure access.

The water station utilizes modern technology and safe equipment such as a backflow prevention device to protect from contamination while filling and loading.

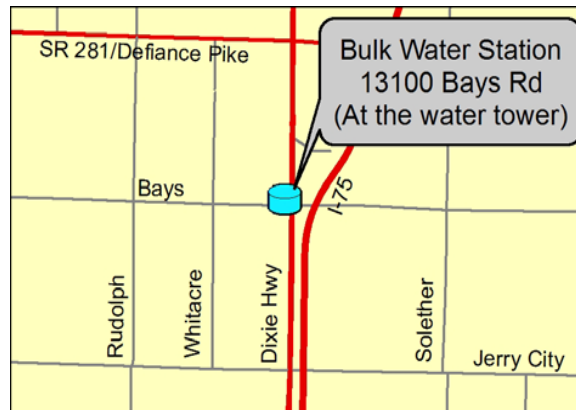
The Sites:

The driveway access at each site is set up and prepared to handle farm trucks, trailers and tractor trailer tankers with plenty of driveway turning radius.

WHAT IS THE COST?

We understand the need for quality potable water in Wood County. These sites were chosen specifically for safe access for trucks and trailers. The water is safe for personal uses such as filling pools, tankers and cisterns as well as for commercial and agricultural use.

- ▶ Water will cost \$7.00 per 1,000 gallons purchased. This will be the minimum amount billed per transaction.
- ▶ Your account will be billed monthly with all bills due by the middle of the next month.
- ▶ Accounts will be billed a late fee if paid past the due date.
- ▶ A one-time set up fee of \$8.00 per card will be billed the first month. Multiple cards can be purchased.
