The Northwestern Water & Sewer District ("District") recently conducted a public meeting with owners and residents to discuss the upcoming wastewater treatment plant project.

In an effort to keep you fully advised of the project status, the intent of this letter is to advise you that the District's Board of Trustees ("Trustees") (who oversee the operation of the District) will hear from the District's staff regarding information and recommendations regarding this project on **Thursday, March 22, 2018, at 7:30 a.m.** at the District's Operations Facility located at 12560 Middleton Pike (SR 582), Bowling Green, Ohio. This information will include the necessity of the project, the design of the project and the allocation of these costs. You are invited to attend to hear this information and to speak in regards to your position in this matter, if you care to do so.

If the Trustees approve such recommendations, a resolution of necessity will be passed and the District will proceed with this project. A unit allocation notice will be mailed to you (certified mail) which will begin the process of enjoining you to the project.
