Re: Todd Street and High Street Waterline Project

Dear Owner/Resident:

The Northwestern Water and Sewer District ("District") would like to provide information on an upcoming waterline replacement project on Todd and High Streets that may affect you. We are also notifying homes and businesses that are located outside the impact area so that you are aware of the impending construction.

The District will be replacing an existing six-inch diameter waterline on Todd Street starting at South Street, north to the railroad and west to High Street. The High Street construction will be between the railroad, south to Main Street. The project will also include portions of an alley between High and Todd Street, adjacent to the elevated storage tank. The purpose of this project is to improve water quality and is no additional cost to you.

R.A. Bores Excavating, Inc. was the awarded contractor and will be performing the work on behalf of the District. Construction is anticipated to start within the next week, weather permitting, with substantial completion by May 1, 2018.

Once the water main is installed, customers in the impacted area will be switched over to over to the new main. There will be minor service interruptions when this occurs. The contractor and/or the District will notify you shortly before this happens. Additionally, the new meter pit at the road will be installed with a backflow device. This may require you to install an expansion tank in your plumbing system.

During this time, local traffic to your home will be maintained. However, some delays may occur during construction. There may be periods of service interruption during construction as well but we will make every attempt to notify you in advance.

The contractor will be responsible for restoration. Restoration will occur when the project is complete. Any damage to yards, driveways, roads, etc. will be repaired after the replacement line is installed. All property within the public right of way is subject to removal for the installation of the waterline system, including landscaping, invisible fencing, irrigation systems, etc. This property will not be the responsibility of the District or the contractor to replace.
