Re: McComb Sanitary Sewer Improvements

Dear Owners/Residents:

The Northwestern Water & Sewer District ("District") is performing repairs on the sanitary sewer system in your area. The improvement project will replace and rehabilitate aging sanitary sewer pipe that is severely deteriorating. This project will also aide in effort by the District to eliminate excessive infiltration into the sanitary sewer system, which is a cause of excessive loading to the treatment facilities and sanitary sewer overflows into receiving waterways.

One method of construction for this project will be a "no dig" technology. This should have minimal impact on you. A liner will be pulled into the existing sanitary sewer pipe and during the curing process of the pipe liner some residents may experience a slight odor or plastic smell. This is not harmful and will rapidly dissipate.

The second method of construction will be an "open cut" excavation. This portion of the project is required because of the extremely poor condition of the existing sanitary sewer pipe. The majority, but not all, of the open cut excavation will take place near the intersection of Liberty St. and Bond St.

The contractor, Edward Kelly & Son's, will be performing the work on behalf of the District. Construction is anticipated to start early 2019 and continue through the winter, completing in the spring of 2019.

The District will have an inspector on-site to address any issues or concerns during construction. All property within the right-of-way is subject to removal for these improvements. This includes items like landscaping, invisible fences, sprinkler systems, etc. A District representative can identify the current right-of-way if needed. These items will not be the responsibility of the District or the contractor to replace. While it is our intent to limit damages and removals, it is sometimes necessary.
