Re: Rossford Area Sanitary Sewer Improvements

Dear Owners/Residents:

The Northwestern Water & Sewer District ("District") is performing repairs on the sanitary sewer system in your area. This project is part of an on-going effort by the District to eliminate excessive infiltration and storm water inflow into the sanitary sewer system which is a cause of excessive loading to the treatment facilities, pumping costs, and sanitary sewer overflows into receiving waterways.

The method of construction for the majority of this project will be a "no dig" technology and will have little to no impact on you. A liner will be pulled into the existing sanitary sewer pipe. During the curing process of the pipe liner, some residents may experience a slight odor or plastic smell. This is not harmful and will rapidly dissipate. However, there will be some excavation to replace a few manholes and install cleanouts on some service laterals.

Crews will also be cleaning and televising service laterals from the main to the home. While televising, the contractor will be placing stakes in your yard to mark the location of the lateral. **Please do not remove these stakes.** A District representative will be following behind within a few day's time to locate these stakes via GPS for our mapping system. Once the lateral location is collected via GPS, the stakes will be removed.

The existing sewer main is located in either the road right-of-way or in an easement. Unfortunately, some landscaping may need to be trimmed or removed to access sanitary sewer appurtenances. Any restoration will occur once the project is completed.

Lake County Sewer Company is the awarded contractor and will be performing the work on behalf of the District. Construction is anticipated to start in January 2019 and be completed in the third quarter of 2019.
