Re: Wastewater Treatment Plant

Dear Resident:

The Northwestern Water and Sewer District ("District") would like to provide an update regarding the construction of the new wastewater treatment plant that will serve the village.

As you know, construction began last fall and remains on schedule to be completed this October. Some of the new improvements include a backup generator if a power failure would occur, state of the art treatment equipment and an increased capacity for treatment compared to the existing plant. The existing plant will be demolished once the new plant goes online.

The project also involves the rehabilitation of existing sewer pipe in several areas of the village. This work will reduce the amount of storm water entering the system which burdens the wastewater treatment plant.

We will reach out again to you later this year to provide a timeline for the debt service payment that each of you will be paying through your monthly bill. We anticipate that the range given by us last year (\$10-\$15 per month) is still current.
