## BOARD UPDATE

The Northwestern Water and Sewer District's Board of Trustees recently accepted the appointment of Mr. Tim Phillips. Mr. Phillips was appointed to The District's Board by the Henry County Commissioners.

Mr. Phillips served on the Board of Trustees at the Henry County Regional Water & Sewer District (HCRWSD). He also spent 42 years as the Water and Sewer Superintendent in the Village of Hamler. Mr. Phillips will serve a three-year term.

"I am pleased to represent Henry County and feel my knowledge of the area and its water and wastewater systems will be an asset to The District's Board of Trustees," said Phillips.

Mr. Phillips fills a new board seat at The District. A merger between HCRWSD and the Northwestern Water and Sewer District became official in December 2019. The merger allowed a tenth board seat to be appointed by the Henry County Commissioners at The Northwestern Water and Sewer District.

## CURRENT PROJECTS

### ROSSFORD - LIME CITY ROAD WATERLINE REPLACEMENT

Through April, intermittent lane restrictions are possible on Lime City and Schreier Roads and Marilyn Drive for waterline replacement. Project investment: \$770,000.

### ROSSFORD: EAGLE POINT SEWER REPLACEMENT

Through April, lane and shoulder restrictions are possible on Eagle Point west of Colony Road for sewer replacement. Project investment: \$1.2 million.

### TROY TOWNSHIP – NSG SEWER LINE INSTALLATION

Through April, lane restrictions are possible on Garling Road just west of Pemberville Road for sewer line installation. Project complete: October. Project investment: \$760,000.
