

PUBLIC NOTICE

The U.S. Department of Commerce, Economic Development Administration (EDA) is considering a request for Federal assistance from Wood County Port Authority, the Wood County Commissioners, Northwestern Water & Sewer District and the City of Rossford to construct the Deimling Road/Lime City Road Infrastructure Improvements project in Rossford, Wood County, Ohio the reconstruction of Deimling Road and the repaving and repair of Lime City Road. Pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 and the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966, as amended, EDA is conducting an environmental assessment (EA) of the proposed project.

The Project includes Roadway, Waterline and Sanitary Sewer Improvements including 6,500 feet of roadway reconstruction, 9,700 feet of roadway resurfacing, 900 lineal feet of 10-inch waterline, 2,100 lineal feet of 12-inch waterline and 4,270 lineal feet of 12-inch sanitary sewer with all necessary appurtenances. The project will be located within the City of Rossford and constructed within the existing rights-of-way of Deimling and Lime City Roads. A project location map is attached. The purpose of the project is to provide adequate roadway capacity for the anticipated traffic of the project beneficiaries and development of the area. It will provide improved access between the US 20 and SR 795 corridor connections to I75, I-280 and the Ohio Turnpike. The Project provides critical infrastructure improvements that will create long-term solutions to economic recovery through job creation, job retention and private sector investment.
