The Northwestern Water & Sewer District is planning for the construction of Sanitary Sewers in the area of Sugar Ridge near your property.

In order to more fully understand the public sewer needs and interest in extending this proposed project, we are asking that you respond to the questions below. Please return in the enclosed self-addressed stamped envelope included for your convenience.

The proposed project will allow for the area to be sewerred through the installation of publicly owned grinder pumps and force main connections. This system permits for extensions to be readily available to nearby customers in the same manner.

To accurately estimate the costs of any possible extension from the currently proposed project, we need information on the potential number of properties interested. There could be significant savings to interested property owners if they choose to connect during this initial phase of the project due to the current funding sources that have been secured.

If we receive enough interest we will prepare more detailed information for your review on costs and available funding. We will also follow up with our formal petition detailing the extension process.
