Re: Sanitary Sewer Project Update

Dear Property Owners:

The Northwestern Water & Sewer District ("District") would like to provide an update on the Sugar Ridge/Mercer Road Sanitary Sewer project. The District is continuing to secure grant funding as mentioned in our meeting last December. While doing this, the District is ready to proceed with the project.

In an effort to keep you fully advised of the project status, the intent of this letter is to advise you that the District's Board of Trustees ("Trustees") (who oversee the operation of the District) will hear from the District's staff regarding information and recommendations regarding this project on **Thursday, October 28, 2021, at 7:30 a.m.** at the District's Operations Facility located at 12560 Middleton Pike (SR 582), Bowling Green, Ohio. This information will include the necessity of the project, the design of the project and the allocation of these costs in the form of a debt charge depending on grant funding received.

You are invited to attend to hear this information and to speak in regards to your position in this matter, if you care to do so. All CDC recommended COVID-19 precautions will be followed, including masks, temperature checks and social distancing.

This letter will include the estimated cost per property owner and provide a date and time for a public meeting where additional project details will be discussed.
