
Annual Meeting Set-May 4th

Need Bulk Water? Filling a Pool?

We sell water to commercial users through a metered facility at the County's Landfill, at the corner of Bays and Rt. 25, at the Weston water tower, at the CSX facility and at the District Operations facility. We offer 24-hour a day access through an "ATM" card which recognizes the owner and bills them for their measured usage. For more information please call us.

Water is inexpensive when filling a pool or reopening a pool in the spring. When faced with buying pool chemicals in the range of \$30-\$100, simply using our public, chlorinated, potable water is cheaper and easier than trying to adjust a pool.



Ohio Utilities Protection Service ("OUPS")

Before you start a construction or landscaping project, pick up the phone and call Ohio's One Call ("OUPS") agency (at least forty-eight hours before work begins). By making this call, you can save time, money and avoid property damage or personal injury. The service will notify the utility companies who will mark the approximate location of underground utility lines in the work area at no cost to residential customers. 
District Received Award for 10th Year-In-A-Row for Accuracy of Financial Statements
