Resolution 2017-38. Acceptance and action on bids received for the Walbridge South Main Street Waterline Abandonment and Replacement, WL #166D. Leonard Michaels made a motion to bring the motion to the table. Doug Miller seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken with all present voting yes. Garret Chamberlain requested that this project be awarded to Tap Construction for \$62,017.00. The engineer's estimate on the project is \$77,000.00, he said. Doug Miller made a motion to approve. Leonard Michaels seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken with all present voting. **Approved**.

Resolution 2017-41. Consideration of a water and/or sanitary sewer discount for persons over 65 years of age. Doug Miller made a motion to bring the resolution to the table. Leonard Michaels seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken with all present voting yes. Kay Ball stated the Village of Walbridge passed a resolution for the District to consider a discount for persons over 65 years of age. Ms. Ball reviewed what others offer as far as discounts and reviewed with the board what the effects would be for those receiving the discount and the rest of the District customers. Ms. Ball stated after review the staff recommends not offering a discount; the discount is not affordable and would have to be subsidized by other customers. Mr. Stalter stated this plant is no longer of use since the sewer flow is not going to the Village of North Baltimore. Leonard Michaels made a motion to approve. Bill Verbosky seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken with all present voting yes. **Approved**.
