Re: New Waterline in Your Area

Dear Resident/Owner:

The Northwestern Water & Sewer District's new waterline replacement project is nearing completion. All homes in the Village will be connected to new source water from the City of Bowling Green.

Beginning approximately 9:00 A.M. until 3:00 P.M. on Thursday November 3, 2016. District crews will be in the Village flushing the new waterline for operational purposes. We would like to mention several items while this flushing occurs:

1. There may be discoloration in the water as the flushing occurs. We recommend avoiding doing laundry while the flushing is performed (should occur over several days.) During this flushing, the water may become white or milky or milky in color. This is due to air in the water and will clear up in a few minutes.
2. Due to this change you could experience clogging in your faucets. Removal and cleaning of aerators may be necessary.

The District hopes you that you find this improvement beneficial to your community. This new waterline will provide the Village with improved firefighting capabilities and water quality.
