Re: Oliver St. Area Sanitary Sewer Improvements

Dear Owners/Residents:

The Northwestern Water & Sewer District ("District") would like to update you on the repairs to the sanitary sewer system on Oliver St. This project is part of an on-going effort by the District to eliminate excessive infiltration and storm water inflow into the sanitary sewer system which is a cause of excessive loading to the treatment facilities, pumping costs and sanitary sewer overflows into receiving waterways. The pipe lining portion for the project was completed over the winter in February on Oliver St.

The next portion of the project will be an "open cut" excavation. This portion of the project is required because of the extremely poor condition of one section of the existing sanitary sewer pipe that couldn't be lined. Because the location of the existing sanitary sewer main is in the pavement of Oliver St., the traffic will be closed to through traffic during the time of installation from Ackerly St. to Liberty St. on Oliver St.

During this time, local traffic to the resident's homes in the construction area will be maintained to the best of the contractor's ability; however, some delays may occur during construction.

The contractor, Advanced Rehabilitation Technology (ART), will be performing the work on behalf of the District. Construction is anticipated to start May 1st and be completed by May 5th for the excavation and replacement of the sanitary sewer. The following week, May 8th to May 12th, the contractor will perform the paving repairs to the street in the disturbed areas.

The District will have an inspector on-site to address any issues or concerns. However, if you have questions or need additional information, please call me at (419) 354-9090, ext. 126. The District will try to accommodate all request and do everything it can to minimize any disturbance that this project may cause.
